

Privacy Policy

1 Collection and Provision of Information

- 1.1 Agate Legal Limited ("us", "we", or "our") may collect information about you when you visit or use our website.
- 1.2 When you visit our website, we may collect general information about such site use, traffic patterns, demand for relevant products, services and information, related site information, and other technical information.
- 1.3 When you visit or use our website, you may also provide us with personal information.

2 Information Sent at Own Risk

The internet is not a secure environment. Any information you send to us, including your email address, is sent at your own risk.

3 Retention and Storage of Information

- 3.1 We may retain and update personal information collected from or provided by you.
- 3.2 We may store your personal information in physical, hard copy form or in electronic form, including with any third party data storage facility or facilities and in cloud storage whether located in or outside New Zealand.

4 Use of Information

- 4.1 We may use your personal information:
 - 4.1.1 For the purpose for which it was collected;
 - 4.1.2 To represent and advise you if you are our client or to represent and advise our client if you are acting on behalf of that client (including to conduct customer due diligence, as required by the Anti-Money Laundering and Countering Financing of Terrorism Act 2009 and associated regulations);
 - 4.1.3 To deal with any conflict of interest (whether commercial or legal in nature);
 - 4.1.4 To obtain credit or other references about you;
 - 4.1.5 For internal business administration purposes;
 - 4.1.6 To undertake credit management (including debt recovery, which may involve disclosing information to debt collectors);
 - 4.1.7 To provide information on developments and issues that may be of interest or relevance to you; and/or
 - 4.1.8 For any specific purpose authorised by you (including under any of the terms of any engagement we may have in place).

5 Disclosure of Information

- 5.1 We may disclose personal information about you if:
 - 5.1.1 It is required or authorised by you (including under any of the provisions of paragraph 4 above or any of the terms of any engagement we may have in place);
 - 5.1.2 It is required by law; or
 - 5.1.3 It is required or permitted by the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act (Lawyers: Conduct and Client Care) Rules 2008 of the New Zealand Law Society.

6 Access to Information
